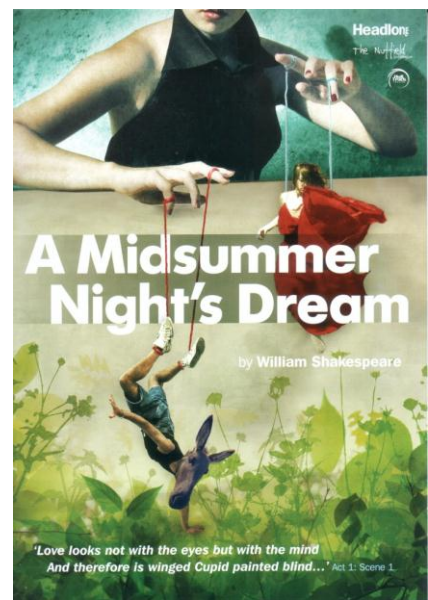
Theatre Review
